

Regular Council August 7, 2018

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. Gwinner, Broker, Kleber, Failor, & Robbins. Cou. Cox was absent. Cou. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Kleber. Accepted by all. Cou. Broker made motion to accept reports; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all. Cou. Gwinner made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Cou. Gwinner and Cou. Kleber met and discussed the junk ordinance. They compared ours with Attica's and made some changes they would like to see implemented. Council and Solicitor received copies to look over. We will come to next meeting with ideas.

NEW BUSINESS:

Cou. Broker made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2018-06 (amending Ord. 2012-06) (modifying fee schedule for building department); 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all. Cou. Broker made motion to adopt Ord. 2018-06; 2nd by Cou. Kleber. Accepted by all. Cou. Broker thinks residents should be made aware of this. Mayor said ordinance will be posted at the store and other public places.

Police Chief said the car they are trying to purchase is going up for bid. We will put a bid in (September).

Mayor said the fire chief reported that we have answered 56 squad calls this year. Margareta assisted with two of these. We had an applicant for firefighter from Vickery. Council decided this was too far away.

Cou. Kleber made motion to go to executive session to discuss personnel matter; 2nd by Cou. Failor. Accepted by all. Meeting broke for 15 minutes; Cou. Robbins made motion to go back to regular session; 2nd by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all.

Mayor would like to hire Jeremy Danklefsen as full time maintenance supervisor with consent of council. Cou. Gwinner made motion to consent to hiring Jeremy Danklefsen; 2nd by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all.

Mayor said we had storm damage last night and a tree came down at the shelters. The insurance adjuster will be here tomorrow.

PUBLIC CONCERNS:

Matt Aicholz asked what council is doing to be proactive on the revenue issue in the village. He said other municipalities have things such as resort and bed taxes, among other sources of revenue. Cou. Gwinner said he would be glad to sit down with Matt and go over his ideas. Cou. Broker said we are trying to see what we can do to create revenue

with the bridge. Matt said he would be willing to help with opportunities if council will work on it too.

Michelle Horning thinks we should regulate weekly rentals of homes in the village. Cou. Gwinner said he will speak with solicitor and see what we can do.

Cou. Gwinner made motion to adjourn; 2nd by Cou. Broker.
