

Regular Council December 3, 2019

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. Broker, Gwinner, Behrendt, Failor, & Robbins. Cou. Aichholz was absent. Cou. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Failor. Accepted by all. Cou. Broker made motion to accept reports; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all. Cou. Behrendt made motion to pay bills; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all except Cou. Failor who made an exception of check # 27125.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

Cou. Gwinner made motion to appoint Alex File as part time probationary patrolman, until he receives re-certification as police officer; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all. Solicitor swore Alex in.

We had 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Ord. 2019-17 (temporary 2020 budget.)

Cou. Broker got bids for gutters for park pavilions and fire station. The fire station is \$518 for gutters, and park is \$1225. Cou. Broker said there was a lot of debris built up in the fire station gutters. Cou. Failor suggests getting gutter guards installed at the same time. Discussion. Cou. Failor made motion to accept the bids for gutters at the fire station and two park pavilions, with the addition of up to \$750 for gutter guards; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Gwinner. Accepted by all.

Cou. Gwinner made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2019-18 (accepting donation of police car from police association); 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. Gwinner made motion to adopt Ord. 2019-18; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

Fire Chief said the fire truck was towed for repairs yesterday and should be back by the end of the week.

Police Chief said we have the 2014 police car and are having decals put on tomorrow. We received a community action grant for \$1500 and will be using that for a radio and scanner for new car. The police association paid for all.

Chief would like to donate the old crown Victoria (20 years old) to Sandusky Police Academy. The high school students would work on it and the academy would use it for training. Solicitor said we would need an ordinance for this.

Mayor said the spark plugs, wires, and stabilizer link were replaced on the other police car.

Mayor said the brake line broke on the truck, so leaf pickup will have to wait until repairs are made.

Mayor said as elected officials we all need to follow the rules and signs in the village.

Cou. Robbins made motion to adjourn; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Failor.
