Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. Broker, Behrendt, James, Aichholz, & Robbins. Cou. Tully was absent. Cou. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all. Cou. Broker made motion to accept reports; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all. Cou. Robbins made motion to pay bills; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Solicitor swore in Bradley Griffin as part time police officer.

Cou. Aichholz made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2020-10 (Purchase of used rescue squad, paid for with CARES act money for \$35,000); 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. Aichholz made motion to adopt Ord. 2020-10; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all.

Cou. Aichholz made motion to have Trick or Treat from 4-6pm on October 31<sup>st</sup>.

Cou. Behrendt made motion to have “Pumpkins in the Park” on October 25 from 2 – 4pm (preceded by a golf cart decorating parade at 1pm. (Meet in parking lot across from hall at 1pm); 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all.

Mayor said we purchased ten laptops and two tablets, and an LED sign with Cares Act money. He would like council to think about where they would like the sign placed.

Cou. Broker made motion to purchase needed equipment for the new rescue squad, as well as transporting it here from Pennsylvania, for not over \$3000; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all.

Police Chief thanks council, mayor, and clerk for the hazard pay for police officers. (Paid from CARES ACT money).

Nancy Hannon said residents can vote on the Halloween flowerpots along the Bayfront, at the businesses or on the Village Facebook page. Cou.
