

Regular Council May 15, 2018

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. Gwinner, Broker, Kleber, Failor, Cox, & Robbins. Cou. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all. Cou. Gwinner made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Matt Old and Solid Waste coordinator Tiffani McNeely were at the meeting. Mr. Old spoke about Erie County Community Housing Improvement & Preservation grant money which is available to help low income residents make home repairs. There is a \$1000 tire credit for municipalities and \$2500 clean up grant money.

Cou. Gwinner asked solicitor if he had researched millage for tax. Solicitor misunderstood and researched income tax rules. He said municipalities can impose up to a 1% income tax without the vote of the electorate. He said there are approximately 300 homes in the village.

Cou. Failor said zoning board met last week and the resolution we previously passed needs minor correction. Solicitor will take care of this.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor said there is a law enforcement memorial ceremony this Sunday at 2pm at Washington Park.

Cou. Cox said Wanda Robertson and Jim Johnson want to put up another gazebo on the bay front across from the Bay View Center and Bay Bell. There will be no cost to village and Boy Scouts will put it up. This would be to honor Bob Robertson. Cou. Broker made motion to allow this; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all. Cou. Broker thinks we should do landscaping around the gazebos.

Cou. Kleber gave council copies of our trash ordinance and a sample of one from another community to compare with. She wants council to look them over and come back to next meeting with ideas. She thinks we need to update our current ordinance.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Resident questioned if we have any rules about weekly rentals. Mr. Old said Sandusky has a permit fee. Solicitor will look at the Sandusky ordinance.

Resident questioned work at the Lakeside Motel. Mayor said they have permits and are in process of repairing it.

Cou. Broker made motion to adjourn; 2nd by Cou. Robbins.
