

Regular Council, July 3, 2018

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. Gwinner, Broker, Kleber, Failor, Cox, & Robbins. Cou. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all. Cou. Broker made motion to accept reports; 2nd by Cou. Kleber. Accepted by all. Cou. Gwinner made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

State Representative, Steve Arndt spoke. He wanted to introduce himself and talk about some legislation. He also answered question from Cou. Gwinner. He left his cell phone number if anyone wants to contact him.

Cou. Broker and Cou. Gwinner will be on the tax incentive review committee. It meets once a year.

Mayor said we need to schedule meetings for recreation, fire, & street committees.

Resident said the dumpster at Rayz on the Bay is still in the right of way. Zoning Inspector said he had pledged to move it months ago. Mayor will call Ray. Resident complained of a neighbor whose property is a mess. Solicitor said we need to check our noxious weed ordinance and see if it applies in this case. We may need to refer it to the Health Department.
