

Regular Council September 4, 2018

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. Gwinner, Broker, Kleber, Failor, Cox, & Robbins. Cou. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Kleber. Accepted by all. Cou. Broker made motion to accept reports; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all. Cou. Gwinner made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Jeff Jackson gave update on the sculpture for the bridge. The drawings are ready. It was confirmed that it can be built. He has a few more things to do before starting the funding work. He will have a display at the upcoming festival.

Mayor thanked Ron Cox for the repairs at the park shelter. He did a good job. Mayor asked if anyone knew when the work at the park would be done. She was told there are holes that were not covered. We will have our maintenance men cover them. We need to find out when the work will be completed.

Regarding the IworQ software, the county said they will probably pay the one time fee of \$800 and we would have to cover the \$1200 per year fee.

We are waiting to hear back from insurance company on the possibility of leasing the concession stand at the park.

Cou. Gwinner made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2018-08 (posting village ordinances); 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all. Cou. Gwinner made motion to adopt Ord. 2018-08; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all.

Mayor said she has gotten complaints regarding speed on roads.
Mayor said Jay Danklefsen is doing a good job.

NEW BUSINESS:

Cou. Gwinner made motion to adopt Res. 2018-02 (accepting tax levies and rates set by budget commission); 2nd by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all.

Fire Chief said we had 12 runs last month and one so far this month, making a total of 68 for the year. He just signed up two more firefighters for EMT school.

Trick or Treat will be October 31st from 6 to 8 pm.

Cou. Broker made motion to go to executive session for personnel matter; 2nd by Cou. Kleber. Accepted by all. Meeting broke for 15 minutes. Cou. Broker made motion to go back to regular session; 2nd by Cou. Gwinner. Accepted by all.

Solicitor said council discussed zoning inspector position and if he should be a village employee or an independent contractor. No action was taken.

Mayor got okay from state to dispose of boxes of old records (part of records retention program). They will be shredded.

PUBLIC CONCERNS:

Resident asked when more work would be done on Lakeside Motel. Mayor said she contacted John Zimmerman and he will talk to them this week.

Resident mentioned a house that looks very bad. Mayor said we sent a certified letter but have not heard back.

Resident asked how a house gets foreclosed on. Solicitor says it is at the discretion of the county auditor and prosecutor's office.

Cou. Robbins made motion to adjourn; 2nd by Cou. Broker.
