OLD BUSINESS:

Solicitor will have zoning ordinance with changes ready for next meeting. We will do three readings.

Bid opening for lots had no offers. Cou. S. Broker made motion to have solicitor prepare ordinance to begin the process again for selling the property for minimum bid of \$31,900; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all.

NEW BUSINESS:

Cou. Aichholz made motion to spend up to \$500 for garden soil (including delivery) for the community garden; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

Cou. S. Broker made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2022-07 (disposal for scrap value of surplus equipment); 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. S. Broker made motion to adopt Ord. 2022-07; 2nd by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all.

Cou. James said Christmas decorations are being stored at a park shelter but shelter needs to be emptied. We would like to get volunteers to paint them. We will move them back to garage bay.

Mayor said catfish tournament was changed to only Saturday, instead of Saturday and Sunday. Mayor suggested a bank tournament on Sunday for Fathers/Sons & Daughters, since it will be Father's Day. Tournament sponsor will get back with Mayor after he checks with vendors.
