

Regular Council March 19, 2019

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. Broker, Gwinner, Behrendt, Failor, & Robbins. Cou. Cox was absent. Cou. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all. Cou. Gwinner made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Cou. Failor presented council with zoning board recommendations for a new fee schedule, which is more in line with other communities in the area. There was discussion. Cou. Robbins made motion to have solicitor prepare ordinance which encompasses the new fees; 2nd by Cou. Broker. Accepted by all.

We had first reading of Ord. 2019-07 (tuition and training reimbursement),

Discussion on Ord. 2019-08 (temporary parking permits for special events). Cou. Gwinner made motion to change proposed daily fee from \$150 to 50; 2nd by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all.

We had first reading of this ordinance.

Cou. Broker would like to see the shoreline improved. He suggests painting benches and poles and having Rick design flowerbed areas with perennials. Cou. Broker made motion to purchase paint for benches from the recreation fund for not more than \$150 with labor being done by volunteers; 2nd by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all.

Mayor said Michael O'Toole completed the storm sewer moving project.

Cou. Broker would like to develop a storm sewer cleaning plan, especially along the shoreline.

Mayor would like recreation and shoreline committee meetings soon.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor said the chipper is not running. Maintenance dept. is trying to figure out the problem. They are getting a fuel filter to start with.

The bridge was opened today.

Tomorrow is Patrolman Nick Peters last day. He is joining the Sandusky Police Department. Mayor thanks him for his service to Bay View.
