

Regular Council July 20, 2021

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor gave council copies of zoning book changes, which the zoning board would like approved. Mayor suggests council look over and come back with questions and discussion at the next council meeting. Be prepared to vote on changes.

NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion on no wake buoys. Solicitor sees no issues with the paperwork, and mayor signing with council approval. The Property Owners' Association will maintain and put in and take out buoys. Village will apply for grant money. Buoys will be stored behind village hall. We checked with our insurance carrier and there is no increase in premium. Cou. Broker made motion to authorize mayor to work with the Bay View Property Owners' Association and sign the application for the "no wake buoys."; 2nd by Cou. Robbins. Accepted by all.

Cou. Broker would like us to re consider the sale of some village property. He questioned if we could use a realtor. Solicitor will check on this.

Mayor Said Bill Ladley will come to a meeting soon.

Cou. Tully questioned what to do about a house with many health violations. Mayor suggested contacting Craig Ward from the Health Dept.

FLOOR:

Jim Johnson from Fire Dept. said our new firefighter, Isaiah Ward needs turnout gear for \$2700. Cou. Robbins made motion to purchase the turnout gear; 2nd by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all.

Mayor gave council copies of a letter he received, with suggestions for cleaning the pier. We will discuss at next meeting.
