

Regular Council September 6, 2022

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. S. Broker, Behrendt, James, K. Broker, Grieger, & Aichholz. Cou. S. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all. Cou. S. Broker made motion to accept reports; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. S. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all.

VISITOR:

James Garrett spoke regarding possibility of hosting “The International Taste of the Caribbean and South America” event in Bay View. It would be in either August or September of next year. A percentage of the proceeds would go to the village. Council will put together a list of questions which mayor will email to Mr. Garrett and come back to council with answers. Then a decision will be made.

OLD BUSINESS:

Regarding a bed tax, Mayor suggests we hold off on a decision until spring, giving us more time to think about it. Cou. S. Broker suggests a flat registration fee every year. We will table this for now.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor stated that getting resident input for our committees is a good idea. Then council members of the committee will present to council for approval.

Cou. S. Broker made motion to adopt Res. 2022-07 (accepting tax rates and levies from budget commission); 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all.

Cou. S. Broker made motion to spend another \$378 for the fence project (to add a six-foot gate); 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all,

Mayor is getting three estimates for heating and cooling. One bid is back, waiting on the others.

The bucket truck has been sold.

Cou. Behrendt said Pumpkins in the Park will be held October 23rd from 2 to 5. We are adding a haunted house and hayride. Cou. Behrendt made motion to reserve park shelters Friday, Saturday, and Sunday that weekend; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all.

Cou. S. Broker asked if covid funds can be used for roads. We will research this.

FLOOR:

Mr. Gebard complained about the concrete on the shoreline with rods sticking up. Mayor will look into this.

Cou. S. Broker made motion to adjourn; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker.
