

Regular Council February 21, 2023

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. S. Broker, Behrendt, James, K. Broker, Grieger, & Aichholz. Cou. S. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. S. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Cou. Grieger made motion to purchase new sign for Kenna Stimmel for total cost of \$172.80; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion on possibility of putting a porta potty at the park. We need to think about where to place it and decide if it is a good idea or not. We may also look into possibility of Firelands Vending putting a juice machine at park.

Cou. Aichholz made motion to replace toilet in men's restroom at park for not more than \$400; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

Mayor will get estimates on eliminating pole at park and re-routing electricity to the shelters.

Cou. Broker questioned if our police officers are certified as first responders. Officer Porter said they get training through the basic academy which must be renewed at certain times. He said in-house training would be a good idea. Cou. Broker questioned if patrolmen can drive the squad. Mayor said there is a fire committee meeting with Chief Roesch next Monday and all issues will be discussed.

Council approved letter mayor passed out, to be sent to village residents, having them rate the 2023 goals according to priority. Cou. Grieger made motion to purchase stamps and send out letters; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

Officer Porter mentioned a dock which is by the road. Mayor will call Chuck Fresch tomorrow about this.
