

Regular Council July 18, 2023

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. S. Broker, Behrendt, James, K. Broker, Grieger, & Aichholz. Cou. S. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all. Cou. Grieger made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

Michelle Butler and Jim Brown from Ohio Division of Wildlife spoke regarding turkeys. They do not protect the type of turkeys we have in Bay View. One concern is the spread of disease.

OLD BUSINESS:

Council decided to locate the new building along the original footprint. (Adjacent to fire station). Cou. S. Broker will get new measurements and have a new schematic for next meeting. Fuel tanks will need to be moved and the concrete bid may change.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor said resident wants speed bumps on Iroquois Trail. Two dogs were run over recently. Council will consider this.

Cou. Grieger made motion to spend \$9602.66 on fire expenditures (11 SCBA units, lease agreement for WGGN tower, share of grant writer and share of moving radio tower); 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all.

Mayor brought up topic of an ordinance to protect domesticated feral wildlife in village.

Cou. Grieger made motion to purchase \$500 worth of river rock for bay front; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

Mayor thanks Rick Hogrefe for donating \$140 to bridge maintenance.

Cou. Aichholz made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2023-11 (prohibiting camping in all public areas of Bay View); 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. Aichholz made motion to adopt Ord. 2023-11; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

Cou. Aichholz made motion to table the “no parking along bayfront” discussion; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

PUBLIC CONCERNS:

Resident suggested putting the no parking along bayfront information on the electronic sign after motion is passed by council.

Resident said she thinks we should pursue regulating the short-term rentals. Mayor said we are still working on this. Council was told to have a solid plan before we bring it back to the table.

Resident who is a wildlife biologist offered to speak to anyone after meeting regarding the turkeys.

Cou. S. Broker made motion to adjourn; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker.
