

Regular Council October 17, 2023

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. S. Broker, Behrendt, James, K. Broker, Grieger, & Aichholz. Cou. S. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Behrendt. Accepted by all. Cou. S. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Cou. S. Broker said work on new building will take place in the spring. Fuel tanks still need to be moved.

Discussion on Cody Pass. We will wait until spring to make decisions on this.

Cou. James gave solicitor information on transient rentals. He will look it over and discuss at next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Cou. S. Broker made motion to adopt Res. 2023-04 (designating Civista Bank as our depository for next five years); 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

Solicitor received more paperwork regarding the petition to vacate Parkview Trail. He will write a response letter and send copies to council.

Cou. Grieger made motion to spend up to \$250 on fall decorations for the poles along bayfront; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

Cou. Grieger made motion to spend \$275 on a lift basket truck to be used at police station for replacing light bulbs; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all.

Mayor said the police department needs a new roof. We will put this in the budget for next year.

Cou. Grieger had mayor and council sign a letter to Tim King asking for monetary assistance for possible shoreline grant.

Cou. James said the Santa house was delivered and set up.

Cou. Behrendt said the “pumpkins in the park” event was a success. 60 children participated.

Cou. S. Broker made motion to adjourn; 2nd by Cou. Grieger.
