Regular Council April 2, 2024

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. S. Broker, K. Broker, James, Drossman, Grieger, & Aichholz. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept reports; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Cou. S. Broker said he is working with the fire marshal to get approval for the fuel tanks at new building site.

Solicitor was not here, but mayor said he is working on the sale of Cody Pass and transient rental issues.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor gave council copies of changes to zoning book which the zoning board recommends. Number of lots to build a home and square footage are issues. He told council to look it over and come to next meeting to make decision.

Cou. Drossman made motion to have garage sales be on the 2nd weekend of June from now on; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all. This year that will be June 7th, 8th, and 9th.

There was discussion on additional lights and heaters for the shelter houses. Council decided to get electrician's opinion and estimates before making decision.

Mayor called an asphalt company and got estimate of \$218,000 to pave from entrance of East Bay View Drive to the hall. Street committee will do more research.

Mayor said policeman, Mike Frank, retired, effective March 25th.

Mayor got a text from Rayz on the Bay, saying they will be handing out wristbands for patrons to view the solar eclipse from Rayz. There will be a \$5 donation which will be given to the village for bay front improvements.

PUBLIC CONCERNS:

Joyce Behrendt thinks we need more lights at the shelters for the kids' functions.

Daryl Pasek thinks heaters for shelters are a good idea. He also said since this is an election year, council should approach Marcy Kaptur and other officials to try to get money for roads and the bridge.

Mayor said the village website has a lot of information for village residents. Anything that goes on the village Facebook page will be posted on the Mayor's Corner on the website.
