

Regular Council May 21, 2024

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. K. Broker, S. Broker, James, Grieger, & Drossman, Cou. Aichholz was absent. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all

OLD BUSINESS:

The next step in selling Cody Pass is the vacation process. Solicitor will work on this.

Solicitor is working on amending the zoning code book. He will present it to council at the next meeting for their consideration.

NEW BUSINESS:

Cou. K. Broker made motion to adopt Res. 2024-02 (asking county auditor to certify amount 6 mill renewal levy for current expenses would bring in) 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

Discussion on closing north side of BayView Drive from Bubbles to the village hall. It was decided not to do this since there would not be much notice.

Mayor requested that the audience not have private conversations during council meetings.

Cou. Grieger said he thinks we need 17 stop signs, 1 children at play sign, and 2 no parking signs. Mayor said the next step is to see what the cost would be.

Mayor will print out the three estimates he got for the electrical work at the park shelters and put them in councils' mail slots, so they can review before next meeting.

Mayor said Denny is willing to stay on the payroll to help out if we need work done on vehicles. His last day is July 1st. Mayor will put ad in newspaper for lawn mowing help.

PUBLIC CONCERNS:

Police Chief said she will double check the stop signs. She asked if mayor knows how many applicants there are for the catfish tournament. Mayor said no.

Daryl Pasek thinks it would be smarter to divide the Cody Pass property differently.
