Discussion on police levy. We will have solicitor prepare legislation for county auditor to possibly put a 4 mill levy on spring ballot.

NEW BUSINESS:

We had 3rd reading of Ord. 2024-15 (temporary appropriations). Cou. K. Broker made motion to adopt Ord. 2024-15; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

We had 3rd reading of Ord. 2024-16 (regulations for having chickens). Cou. K. Broker made motion to adopt Ord. 2024-16; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all except Cou. Drossman who voted no.

We had 2nd reading of Ord. 2024-18 (golf carts).

Cou. K. Broker made motion to approve contract with iWork Transient Rental software; 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

Discussion on creating a no hunting zone along all shorelines that border the village property. Police Chief said there is already a state law regarding this. We will do more research on this.

Mayor is working on transient rental application and chicken application.
