

Regular Council May 20, 2025

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. K. Broker, James, S. Broker, Grieger, Drossman. Cou. Aichholz was absent. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

Cou. Drossman directed solicitor to prepare legislation regarding zoning clean up language for accessory buildings and structures.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

Cou. K. Broker made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2025-07 (authorizing sale of village property to highest bidder); 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Drossman. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to adopt Ord. 2025-07; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all. Solicitor will place ad in newspaper.

Cou. S. Broker made motion to add a second port a potty on the pier; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

Cou. S. Broker made motion to approve up to \$2500 for police cruiser repairs (towing included); 2<sup>nd</sup> Cou. Drossman. Accepted by all.

Lengthy discussion on changing fishing hours on the bayfront. Council directed solicitor to prepare legislation to expand the fishing hours on bayfront from a half hour before sunrise to a half hour after sunset.

Council directed solicitor to prepare legislation for putting a 3 mill levy on November ballot for street infrastructure and repairs.

#### PUBLIC CONCERNS:

Jeanne Congdon said she wants the police in the village and wants to promote our community.

Joyce Behrendt said Bay View was previously promoted for their water, fishing and nature and would like it to stay that way.

Steve Congdon thinks we did not promote our proposed police levy enough and encourages residents to contact him regarding weed cutting and other violations in the village.

Val Hunt spoke about the Health Dept. not doing anything regarding a home that needs addressed.
