

Regular Council July 15, 2025

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. K. Broker, James, S. Broker, Grieger, Drossman, & Aichholz. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

The new tanks for the new building site are in. The electric company needs to dig trenches and do the wiring.

Solicitor gave council copies of a draft regarding no hunting along shorelines. He asked them to reach out to him before the next meeting with questions or concerns.

Solicitor passed out draft of an ordinance regarding amending zoning code at section 4.6. (accessory structures) to review and also a handout related to sexually oriented businesses.

Mayor reported that he and clerk opened the bid for the property for sale. There was only one bid for \$2500 from Denise Collins. She has five days to submit the down payment and 30 days to pay the balance. Solicitor will work on the quit claim deed.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

Cou. Aichholz is working on an OPWC grant for street work. It is a 90/10 match. If we incorporate ADA requirements we may have a better chance. There may be a way to incorporate a walkway bridge. He is going to have mayor email councilmen copy of questions that need answered so he can get council opinions. Then Cou. Aichholz will write something up.

Cou. Grieger questioned the possibility of diagonal parking along the bayfront. Cou. S. Broker said we looked at this in the past and decided that due to setbacks and views, it was not a good idea. Cou. Aichholz said that maybe if we get a grant we could look at widening road.

Mayor said there are problems with the breakers along the bayfront. We need an electrician to evaluate the situation.

PUBLIC CONCERNS:

Daryl Pasek thinks additional parking along bayfront is not a good idea. Grant money could be better spent elsewhere in the village.
