

Regular Council Meeting August 05, 2025

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. K Broker, James, S Broker, Grieger, Drossman, and Aichholz. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading of minutes; 2nd Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept all the reports 2nd by Cou. S. Broker Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to pay the bills 2nd by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

The new tanks for the new building site are in. The Electrical Contractor needs to dig conduit trench and do the wiring.

Solicitor gave Council a working draft copy regarding no hunting along the shorelines. Solicitor also passed out a working draft to Council regarding amending the Zoning Code section 4.6 and a draft of an Ordinance related to sexually oriented businesses in the Village of Bay View.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor asked Council if they had any input on the working drafts that the Solicitor handed out at the previous meeting. All of Council was satisfied with the content of each handout and will be ready to vote on all issues at the next meeting.

Cou. Aichholz asked Council if they had any input on the questions they were emailed about the OPWC grant for street work and no one had any input. Cou. Aichholz stressed to Council the paperwork had to be in by September so he will need all input by the next meeting.

Mayor received the quote of \$3608 from Great Lakes Electric for the work needed on the Electrical Systems on the bayfront. Cou. K. Broker made motion to approve the quote and Cou. S. Broker 2nd. Accepted by all.

Cou. K. Broker made a motion to approve the expenditure of replacement of one of the garage door openers on the Firehouse Building in the amount of \$655 installed by Overhead Door 2nd by Cou. S. Broker.

Mayor discussed the recent flooding rains and the pump station. The controller for the pumps burned up and the pumps were not operational. Maintenance

transported the portable trash pump to the pump station and used it to get the water moving. Mayor contacted Lakecraft Pumps and they arrived very timely. They were able to wire the pumps around the controller so the pumps could be run in manual. The water receded very quickly with 3 pumps running. They replaced the controller later that day and the pumps were then full operational. Maintenance did a great job working in the rain for hours to keep everything working. Village Hall and the Maintenance Building were also flooded and Maintenance took care of that problem as well.

Mayor also informed Council that after all the rain a sink hole has appeared on the corner of E Bayview Drive and E Mohegan. Erie County came out and looked at it and informed us that it was not a sanitary line but a storm water pipe issue. Mayor contacted Fox Excavating and they will be working on it soon.
