

Regular Council September 16, 2025

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. K. Broker, James, Grieger, S. Broker, Drossman, & Aichholz. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

We had 3<sup>rd</sup> reading of Ord. 2025-10 (clean up language in section 4.6 of zoning code) Cou. K. Broker made motion to adopt Ord. 2025-10; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. Drossman. Accepted by all.

We will have 3<sup>rd</sup> reading of Ord. 2025-11 (prohibiting sexually oriented businesses operating in the village) at the next council meeting, after it is revised.

Fire Chief gave list of things the fire dept needs. Cou. K. Broker made motion to purchase up to \$1100 for refurbished computer, separate monitor, printer, & paper towels for fire dept; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all.

Cou. S. Broker made motion to hire James Deatsch, Brittany Ohning, & Cody Lakner to the fire dept; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. K. Broker.

Fire committee will meet to discuss changing how close firefighters need to live to the village, thus expanding our potential candidates.

Council President K. Broker did research on the village street budget and found a place from Norwalk (Charlie's Paving) that can patch nine areas in the village that need work for \$22,000. This includes grinding, patching, and hot asphalt. Cou. K. Broker made motion to hire Charlie's Paving to patch nine interior areas for \$22,000; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cou. S. Broker. Accepted by all. Mayor thanked Cou. K. Broker for researching this for us.

Mayor thanked Cou. Aichholz for submitting OPWC grant application for road work. They accepted our application. Mayor said Tim King offered to help with application if we need it.
