NEW BUSINESS:

We had first reading of Ord. 2025-12 (temporary appropriations for first 3 months of 2026).

Cou. S. Broker made motion to approve up to \$630 for Erie County Stormwater Dept. in case the dry weather outfall inspections require repair; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all.

Cou. S. Broker made motion to give clerk a raise of \$100 per month, beginning Jan. 1st, 2026; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all.

Cou. K. Broker made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2025-13 (authorizing concealed handgun licensee to carry a concealed handgun in permissible village owned buildings); 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. S. Broker made motion to adopt Ord. 2025-13; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker. Accepted by all.

Cou. Grieger asked if we are looking for a new solicitor. Mayor said yes, Mr. Kaufman will set up a meeting with himself, candidate, mayor and council president.
