

Regular Council February 3, 2026

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. K. Broker, S. Broker, Grieger, Drossman, Brace, & Fresch. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept reports; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor will get Cou. Fresch copies of title search and surveys for Cody Pass as soon as solicitor gets our electronic files from Mr. Kaufman

NEW BUSINESS:

Cou. Drossman presented council with input from the zoning board on solar panels. There was some discussion. Talk of a \$50 permit fee. Council will look over paperwork from Cou. Drossman and discuss at a future meeting.

Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept estimate of \$2165 from Great Lakes Electric for eliminating the old wiring for the old fuel tanks and burying the conduit to the light pole; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

There was some discrepancy regarding the Great Lakes Electric estimate for the wiring for the sign at the fire department. Mayor will call them tomorrow to see which estimate is the correct one. We will decide on this later.

Cou. Drossman presented the idea of a possible zoning ordinance addition allowing the village to condemn trees that become a health and safety concern for the public. He suggests we create a resolution to empower the zoning department to identify problem trees and require abatement of hazardous trees and vegetation on private property where such conditions pose a risk to persons, occupied structures, utilities, or public rights of way. Cou. Drossman asks council to review the document he passed out, and discuss further.

Cou. K. Broker made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2026-01 (permanent appropriations for 2026); 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to adopt Ord. 2026-01; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.
