

Regular Council June 2, 2026

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. K. Broker, Grieger, Brace, S. Broker, & Fresch. Cou. Drossman was absent. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept reports; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

NEW BUSINESS:

Cou. K. Broker made motion to adopt a cybersecurity policy for the village; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

Discussion on potential ordinances 2026-05 & 2026-06 (regarding public nuisances, weeds, litter abatement, etc.) Council decided to look ordinances over better and consider at next meeting.

Discussion on sale of Cody Pass. Cou. K. Broker made motion for solicitor to put ad in newspaper to sell it as non-buildable, divided lengthwise down the middle, with an initial starting price of \$15,500 for each side; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all except Cou. Fresch who voted no.

Cou. Brace suggests we look into adopting the International Property & Maintenance Code for the village. He also suggests we adopt the most recent copy of Ohio Fire Code. He will get more info and bring to next meeting.

Police & Fire committees will meet and come up with a succession plan, along with wants and needs for the future.

Mayor got estimates from the new trash hauler and they are quite a bit more expensive than Rumpke.

Discussion on reducing speed limit in village. Solicitor said any roadway less than one mile in length can set the speed limit to under 25 mph. Council talked about setting it to 15 mph. Solicitor will look into this.

Cou. Fresch asked if we can get reports from each department on what they do. Mayor said yes.

Cou. Fresch handed out a paving quote.
