

Regular Council June 16, 2026

Meeting came to order with Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was answered by Cou. K. Broker, Grieger, Brace, S. Broker, Drossman, & Fresch. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept & dispense with reading minutes; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to accept reports; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to pay bills; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Cou. K. Broker made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2026-05 (defining what constitutes public nuisances and requiring abatement); 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all. Cou. K. Broker made motion to adopt Ord. 2026-05; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

Cou. K. Broker made motion to set aside rules on Ord. 2026-06 (addressing grass, litter, weeds on private property and procedure when owner fails to comply); 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

NEW BUSINESS:

Council directed solicitor to prepare ordinance requesting county auditor to certify amount a 3-mill renewal levy will bring in.

Cou. K. Broker made motion to advertise the 2014 Ford Explorer (old police car) for a starting bid of \$4500 on gov. deals; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

Solicitor is working with the county auditor to get parcel numbers for the Cody Pass property and then will put ad in newspaper for 5 consecutive weeks.

Discussion on road repair work. Erie Blacktop gave estimate of \$145,000 for East Bay View Drive, and \$221,000 to include sealing all inner streets. Cou. S. Broker said we need a resolution to apply for a road grant. Cou. K. Broker made motion to have solicitor do resolution to apply for grant; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

Mayor said that Kevin Cannon from Erie Regional Planning said the traffic count hasn't changed from before and he offered to work with us on applying for grants. Mayor said we would appreciate that.

Mayor talked about possibility of a mural being done at village hall. It could be done for \$2000. He said we could solicit donations and see where we stand.

Discussion on cleaning up trees from recent storm. Cou. S. Broker will check on price of renting another chipper. Mayor will get a quote on hiring some of the cleanup done. Cou. K. Broker gave mayor authority so spend up to \$10,000 on clean up; 2nd by Cou. Grieger. Accepted by all.

PUBLIC CONCERNS:

Steve Congdon asked council to consider a bond issue for the roads.

Daryl Pasek advised council to get information out (maybe a public meeting) regarding the 3 mill levy before the November election.

Cou. Grieger made motion to adjourn; 2nd by Cou. K. Broker.
